

Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Kigarama Primary School
and
The ‘**Foundation for Children’s Education in Uganda**’

Objective: To assist students with learning problems to pass exams and finish primary school and qualify for secondary education.

To reach this objective, **Kigarama Primary School** pledges to:

1. Provide remedial teaching following the below schedule:
During each school holiday, for 3 weeks, from Monday to Friday, from 8:30am till 1pm. This remedial teaching will be provided by 6 teachers, to P5, P6 and P7 classes. In addition, during the school terms, remedial teaching will continue: starting one hour before the official opening and one hour after school provided to P5, P6 and P7 classes.
2. The number of students attending this remedial teaching will be recorded and communicated to the ‘**Foundation for Children’s Education in Uganda**’.
3. To monitor the results, individual results of end of term exams of each student participating in remedial teaching, will be communicated to the ‘**Foundation for Children’s Education in Uganda**’.

The ‘**Foundation for Children’s Education in Uganda**’ pledges to:

1. Provide financial support to the teachers that participate of 120000 USHs per month for 2 years to be administrated by the management of Kigarama Primary School. This funding (480000 USHs once every 4 months) will be transferred to the bank account associated with the school, provided the remedial teaching is taking place as agreed, at the beginning of each term.
